For Starters

- 1. What words or ideas come to mind when you hear the word justice?
- 2. What justice issues most naturally capture your heart?

Digging In

Read Psalm 146:7-9

- 1. What do these verses reveal about God?
- 2. How are these verses about justice?
- 3. How can we practically reflect the heart of God revealed here?
- 4. Read James 2:14-20. What is James saying in your own words?
- 5. How are loving deeds related to authentic faith?
- 6. Who are the people James challenges his readers to love?

Bringing It Home

- 1. What does it mean practically for you to do justice?
- 2. Who are the marginalized and powerless people groups in our area?
- 3. What might it look like to live out God's heart for justice in your community?
- 4. Do you agree that the achievement gap is an injustice? Why?
- 5. Would your group consider adopting a teacher? What are the exciting opportunities? What are the concerns? (Please share any feedback to Karrah at kmesser@doorcreekchurch.org)
- 6. Take time to pray that God might use Door Creek, your life group and you as an individual to do justice in our community and that He would be glorified through it all.
