"Family Photo – Rehoboam: Lost Opportunities – 1 Kings 12:1-6" December 21-22, 2013

Big Idea: God given opportunities can lead to reliance or resistance

For Starters

- 1. When were you glad to take advantage of what you thought was a God given or special opportunity? What was the result of acting upon that opportunity?
- 2. What special opportunity in your life did you feel you really blew it or lost it? In retrospect, what would you have done differently?

Digging In

Read 1 Kings 12:1-17

- 1. How did Rehoboam and Jeroboam become advisories (1 Kings 11:26-40)?
- 2. Do you think if Rehoboam had responded to his critic's differently that the Kingdom would have remained intact (1 Kings 11:29-31)? Could Rehoboam have responded differently or was the prophesy regarding Jeroboam going to come true any way?
- 3. Identify the opportunities you think Rehoboam could have shown reliance on God rather than resistance to God. How could he have handled the situation/requests differently?
- 4. As you work through the passage, where are you reminded of Jesus as the perfect King?
- 5. In what way do you see or not see Rehoboam fitting into Jesus' family photo? How would you describe this kind of "grandfather" in your family's photo (2 Chronicles 12:13-16)?

Bringing It Home

- 1. What lessons can you learn from the life of King Rehoboam?
- 2. How does the way you respond to God-given opportunities in your life bless others and honor God?
- 3. Are there any current God—given opportunities in your life right now? How will you respond? What will dictate how you will respond?
- 4. Have you personally responded to the God—given opportunity to rely on King Jesus for your life? When did this become a reality to you?
